BIBLE MEDITATION:

"His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever He saith unto you, do it." John 2:5

DEVOTIONAL THOUGHT:

We must obey whether we can understand or not. When Jesus was at the wedding in Cana, the servants had no way of knowing what Jesus was going to do. Christianity's Dangerous Ideas

A Review of Kenneth Samples book
"Seven Truths that Changed the World"

Dangerous Idea #4

Last month, just in time for Easter, I reviewed Dr. Sample's first dangerous idea, "Not all dead men stay dead". Now we jump ahead to Christianity's dangerous idea #4; The explanatory power of atheism versus Christian theism. This is significant as it precedes an upcoming local debate here in Shreveport. The debate is between Frank Turek, co-author of I Don't Have Enough Faith to be an Atheist and David Silverman, president of the American Atheists. They will square off at Broadmoor Baptist Church, Thursday, April 18, 2013, at 7:00 pm, and debate the topic "Which offers a better explanation for reality, Atheism or Christianity?" The public is invited.

Recent years have seen a change in some atheists' attitude of polite indifference now turned to bellicose hostility. A number of them have written books devoted to denying God's existence and are caustic to religious practice in general, especially Christianity. Notable authors and their books are: Dr. Richard Dawkins: The God Delusion, Sam Harris: Letter to a Christian Nation, the late Christopher Hitchens: God is Not Great and Daniel Dennett: Breaking the Spell. These "four horsemen of the new atheism" travel about speaking to large audiences, often on college campuses. Dr. Dawkins calls religion a "mental virus" and says teaching it to one's children is a form of "child abuse." The overall implication is that all religion (except theirs) is harmful and should be banished from the public realm. Christianity is under assault. They aim to wipe it out.

Dr. Samples fights back by teaching the truth in love and making the case for Christianity and the God of the Bible. In his fourth dangerous truth, Dr. Samples outlines twelve examples of the great power and scope that God's existence has in explaining reality. The weakness of atheism is exposed. Dr. Samples says that the existence of the God of the Bible provides a rationally plausible explanation for:

tians to ask. When we ask this question, it means that we actually care about the eternity of others. Of course, some will ask it because they think that it is close-minded of Christians to say that Jesus is the only way to receive salvation. But, because we believe the Bible to be the Word of God, then we trust that Jesus is the only means of salvation because the Bible says it is thus. (John 14:6, Acts 4:12, Romans

Jesus is the only means of salvation for ALL of mankind, what happens to those who have never heard?"

How can people who have never heard of Jesus be saved? The Bible says that they can not. Does that mean that the only people who can be saved are those living in Christian nations? No! God has made a way. I must caution us at this point because it is clear from the Word of God that

Jesus is "THE way, THE truth, and THE life, and that no one comes to the

tion will not be dealt with here. Instead, we will ask this question: "Since

1. The existence of the universe which is not self-existent but contingent on a creator.

- 2. The beginning of the universe which is best explained by creation from nothing by a Creator.
- 3. The complex order, design, and elegance evident in the universe which is often referred to as Intelligent Design.
- 4. The universe's susceptibility to rational investigation. Since the rational mind of God created the cosmos, we should not be surprised to discover it orderly and discoverable by rational beings made in the image of God.
- 5 The existence of abstract entities like logic, numbers and moral laws defy explanation by natural processes but are easily explained by a loving God
- 6. Conscious beings in the universe are completely inexplicable by physical forces alone but easily explained by the mind of God creating other minds.
- 7. The reality of objective moral values. Without God, objective moral values cannot exist.
- 8. The purpose and significance that human beings yearn for. Without God, life is ultimately purposeless. God has placed a desire and capacity within us to have (eternal) fellowship with him.
- 9. Humankind's innate sense of the divine. Simple observation of the stars above (Psalm 19:1-4) and attention to the conscience within (Rom 2:14-15) render innate evidence for God's existence.
- 10. The enigma of man. Man's greatest achievements reflect God's image while his worst atrocities reveal his fallen nature.
- 11. The extraordinary life, death, and resurrection of Jesus as discussed last month.
- 12. A cumulative case for God's existence. It's comprehensive. The number and magnitude of the above arguments and others far outstrip any other explanation about the reality of our universe. When you put all the evidence together, it's really not a close debate.

Father but by me. (Jesus)" So, Jesus is the only one who can save. That is clear, but God has made a way for people to get to Jesus or for Jesus to get to them even though they may be in the middle of a jungle somewhere. God will make it possible for them to have faith in His Son. Let's begin to look at the Word of God and see how this works. How can God get salvation to those who are not in range of the Gospel? It will probably, and often does, take a miracle.

Acts 14:17 and yet He did not leave Himself without witness, in that He did good and gave you rains from heaven and fruitful seasons, satisfying your hearts with food and gladness.

We see first that God has never left Himself without a witness on the earth to all men. All men have seen seasons and rain. All men have tasted food and been glad. These are witnesses to the fact that there is indeed a God according to the Bible.

Rom 1:20 For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse. We see, also, that men should be able to look at creation and understand the "eternal power and divine nature" of God. That is almost shocking, isn't it? That God, in creation, has made it so clear to ALL men *(cont. next page)*

that He exists that they are "without excuse" for not submitting to Him.

As we realize that all men have enough revelation from God to begin to respond to Him, we should begin to feel hope. God is merciful. That doesn't mean that is going to open wide the gates of heaven and let all unrighteous inside, but it means, in this case, that if someone is responding to the revelation that God has given, then God will give a greater revelation of Himself. Psalm 19:1 reads that "The heavens are telling of the glory of God; And their expanse is declaring the work of His hands." Two thousand years ago, if you were living in Asia, you would have looked up and saw a new star shining. The heavens declare the glory of the Lord, and this new star was placed there by Him. If, in your wisdom, you began to travel towards the star, eventually you would have come to Israel, to the region of Judah, and finally to a little town called Bethlehem. Just as the Lord used general revelation, such as this star, to guide the Wise Men to the baby Jesus, so He has continued to guide those that respond to the revelation of God to deeper and deeper understanding, eventually leading them to the ultimate revelation of Jesus Christ our savior and the savior of the world. As men and women throughout the world respond in obedience to what they know of the one true God, He will reveal Himself in greater ways. Stories in scripture, of the Ethiopian, Cornelius, and Lydia, show what great lengths the Lord will go to just to reach one person. *

Wow, what a God we serve who will reroute missionaries, send dreams, and even rebuke Peter to get the good news of Jesus to those who are responding in obedience to Him. All of our examples here are described as worshippers and God fearers. Yet, they didn't know about Jesus, so what did God do? He changed the course of history to get the Gospel to them. Ever since God redirected Paul away from Asia to Macedonia, the Gospel has gone west. It moved from Jerusalem throughout the Roman Empire and Europe, down to Africa, across the ocean to the Americas, and now is moving across the Pacific Ocean to Asia. Many leading missions teachers believe that the Gospel will continue this course of spreading until it gets back to where it started...Jerusalem, and then the whole earth will have the good news of Christ, and it all started with Paul being led by the Spirit of God to Lydia. Rejoice, for our God is one who is merciful to the seeker... those who are humbly responding to revelation. So, how is this still happening today? Listen to what is being reported about God's miraculous outreaches to those who can't hear of Him without it:

"More than one-third of the converts to Christianity in Turkey say they came to Christ because He appeared to them in a dream...a team from

Fuller Seminary in California documented 600 cases in which Muslims found new life in Jesus because of dreams or visions." Stories of not only Muslim men and women, but many other lost souls, finding Jesus through miraculous means are flooding in off the mission field. Many have shared that a man in a white robe with a beard and scars in his hands has appeared to them and given them an address or directions of where they can find the TRUTH. When they arrive at the specified address, they meet a missionary who gives them a Bible and shares Christ with them. They immediately remember the scars in the strange visitor's hands when they hear of His crucifixion. God is going out of His way to get the truth that Jesus Christ is the Savior of the world to those who may not ever hear otherwise. Our God is so merciful. Jesus is the only way. God will not make another way besides Christ, but God will make ways for the lost to meet this Shepherd King. Remember, God isn't going to decide one day to just allow every nonbeliever into Heaven, but to those that are responding to the light that they have, He is giving more light. In order to be saved, they need the light of Christ to shine on them. Let us pray that like the wise men of old, the lost of the world would follow the light of God to Jesus, and let us think of how we might get the good news to those who have not heard.

Let Isaiah, 9:2 be our prayer: "The people who walk in darkness will see a great light; Those who live in a dark land, The light will shine on them."



What is the 10/40 Window?


The 10/40 Window is the rectangular area of North Africa, the Middle East and Asia approximately between 10 degrees north and 40 degrees north latitude.

It would be understandable if your first thoughts about South Sudan were shaped by decades of civil war, "lost boys", and other discouraging realities. South Sudan is the newest nation in the world, having gained independence in July 2011, with a population of over 10 million people. Right now, there are Bible translations in progress in seven languages in South Sudan. Translations are planned for ten more languages and may be needed in six additional languages (pending further research).

Cameroon has been a high strategic priority for Bible translation for several years. Bible translation is in progress in around 100 languages, currently with 79 languages still waiting for Scripture.

The reality is that each hearing impaired community has a unique language and culture of their own. Through Wycliffe Associates, teachers of any age and experience can use their teaching skills to accelerate Bible translation. Karen is part of a Wycliffe Associates support team that serves missionaries in St. Petersburg, Russia, by providing their elementary-aged children with a quality education. These families are there to carry out a variety of roles to support Bible translation in the region. And the ministry of people like Karen is a tremendous blessing to the parents because one of their primary concerns is securing a good education for their kids. In fact, lack of adequate schooling for their children is a key reason why missionaries leave the field. The International Academy where Karen teaches includes children from the local community, some of whom have never opened a Bible. "Very few places do teachers get to have such spiritual influence on the children," Karen says.

Today about 350 million people cannot read the Bible in their own language. But together we have an opportunity to bring God's word to the millions of men, women & children who are still without it.



A Translation Challenge: The Son of God

SUMMARY OF AN ONGOING CONTROVERSY

The following is not an expression of any new thinking or a new position statement from Wycliffe on the issue of the translation of the divine familial terms. Rather, it is a summary



For almost eighty years, Wycliffe has engaged in the important and challenging ministry of Bible translation, serving millions of minority language speakers around the world. One particular challenge—the translation of the terms used to describe the unique relationship between God the Father and the Son of God in some languages that are spoken in communities dominated by Islam—has gained public attention. As an online petition circulated early in 2012, some began to make claims that Wycliffe is taking the term "Son of God" out of Scripture and making "Muslim-friendly" Bibles that include translation choices designed to appease Muslims. These claims are not true.

Wycliffe remains unashamedly committed to the integrity of Scripture and the doctrine of the Trinity—God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. We want to assure you that we are not removing terms for "God the Father" and "Son of God" from the Bibles that we are translating into other languages. Instead, we are seeking the most accurate way to translate those terms from the original Greek and Hebrew texts. Good translation does not simply take the words of a text in one language (like English) and find those words in another language, both because of differences in meaning of words influenced by culture and context and because of differences in grammatical structures of language.

Those who hold various positions in this controversy over how best to translate the terms referencing the Son of God and God the Father



agree that getting it right is critical. The point being contested (in a debate that has gone on in various forms for centuries) is whether accuracy of meaning is more important or less important than the exactness of a word.

There are nearly seven thousand living languages in the world. A significant number of them are spoken by communities dominated by Islam, and most of them do have a common word for "son" that conveys accurate meaning. Wycliffe personnel are working in almost fifteen hundred language projects around the world involving communities from many different religious backgrounds. This challenge involves only a handful of those languages that do not have a common word for "son" that conveys accurate meaning. And where it has come up, translation teams have prayerfully searched for a solution that would most accurately and clearly communicate the relationship between God the Father and God the Son as it is presented in the original Greek and Hebrew texts.

Wycliffe is committed to maintaining the integrity of God's Word. Contrary to what some have suggested, we are not ashamed of the truth of the Gospel and of Jesus' identity as the Son of God. Motivated by our deep commitment to integrity and by our conviction that we serve as part of the whole Church, we have asked a respected third party—the World Evangelical Alliance (WEA)—to review our practices. We anticipate their response by April 2013. Our dedication to this process includes our commitment to submit to the translation guidelines approved by this panel.

While the WEA is conducting their review, we have put those few projects in question on hold.


